10. Requirements

Eligible for competition are only athletes who are affiliated with the WTF, ETU, DTU and BTU. Proof must be provided with a valid DTU passport or an equivalent legitimation. A passport, ID card or equivalent must not be provided. Every athlete has to participate in a sound health condition. Every club ascertains that their minors have their parents' permission for taking part at the tournament. Therefore, the starting permission for minors lies within the clubs' responsibility, not the BTU's. When asked for by the BTU, a club's representative must provide the written permission of the parents on the day of the tournament; if he/she cannot provide it, the minor can be excluded from the tournament.

By registering, all athletes declare their permission for their names being published in starting and result lists on the internet.

11. Team representative

Per club, one representative has free access. The representative must wear team suit and shoes with pale soles.

12. Referees

Referees from the regional associations, as well as judges from the participating nations please send their wish to participate until **06. February 2010** to head of referees, Christian Nuissl. After receiving the registration, the referees will be informed if they can be used. Accommodation and journey have to be arranged by themselves.

13. Competition rules

In accordance with the rules for Poomsae competition of the German Taekwondo Union (WOP) - Stand: 12/2008 and the definitions in this announcement

Teams can have competitors from different clubs and nations. The age class and the competition class are obligatory! Deadline for membership in the older age group is the completion of one's age on the day of the tournament at midnight.

For pair, synchron and team/mixteam competition you have to present the poomsae from the member with the lowest belt graduation. With the registration you have to fix the club for the team. If no club fixed we will take the club which have registered the team with the registration form.

Competitors with 8., 7. and 6. Kup can present the same poomsae in all three rounds. Competitors with 5. Kup and higher must present four different poomsae.

14. Procedure

general:

- In all competition classes we will present 4 poomsae.
- Points from round 1 and 2 will be erased.
- The competitor will start and end the presentation independent.

First round (1. round) = division 1

LK1: Each athlete has to perform the poomsae (in accordance to the belt graduation) from division 1.

LK2: Each athlete has to perform the drawn poomsae from division 1

→ For both classes: In the case of 5 or less participants, the 1. and 2. round will be eliminated.

Semifinal (2. round) = division 2

The best 10 athletes and athletes with equal points from the first round from LK1 and LK2 perform one self choosed poomse from division 2.

→ For both classes: In the case of 10 or less participants in a class, the 2. round will be eliminated.

Final (3. round) = division 2

The best 5 athletes and athletes with equal points from round 2 from LK1 and LK2 will perform two self choosed poomsae from division 2. In between poomsae 1 and 2, the athlete has 1 minute for preparation, but must remain on the competition area. After this minute, the athlete must start with poomsae 2. A delay will be sanctioned with a deduction.

In the case of a tie in the final, a play-off has to be performed, with a poomsae that has already been performed in round 1. The judges will decide per vote.

15. Evaluation

Single evaluation according to the „new WTF System“ for each athlete (technique / presentation).

Time requirements (2 Min) will be ignored at this tournament and the evaluation.

a) technique evaluation: Start with 5,0 – commission 0,1 and 0,5

b) presentation evaluation: It's a combination out of five sectors (min. 2,5 / maxi. 5,0)

The summation of the technique evaluation and the presentation evaluation will build the total conclusion (max. total conclusion: 10,0). The summation of the total conclusion from each final poomsae will build the total result (placement).

The **club evaluation** occure with the point system from the BTU (points: Gold 6 / Gold without fight 3 / Silber 3 / Bronze 1)
